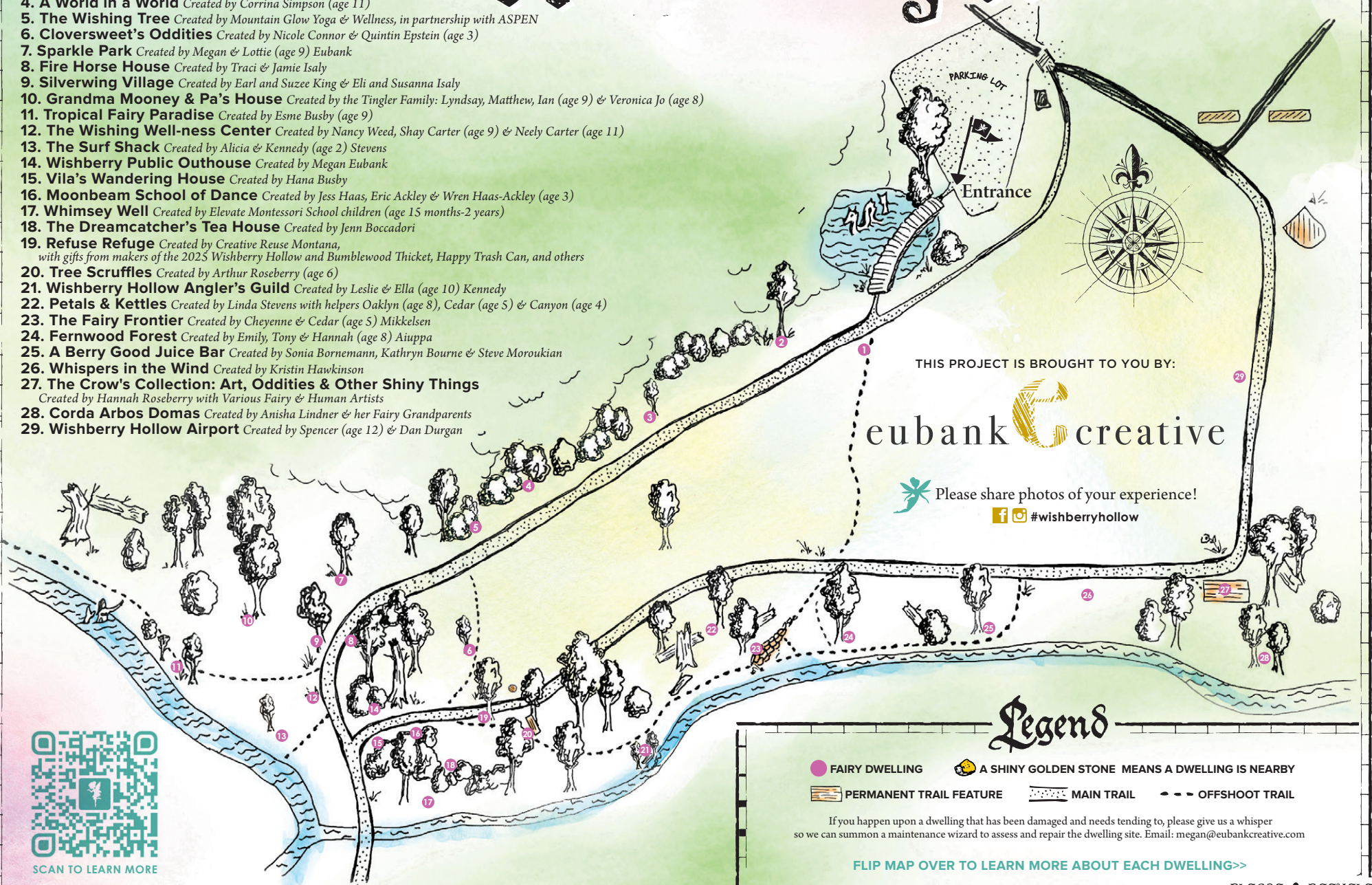

### 27. The Crow's Collection: Art, Oddities & Other Shiny Things

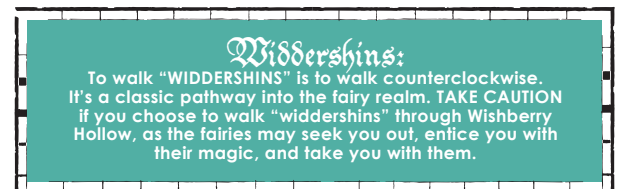
